### Hoss Hosts *Klunkerz* Producer and Cast at Sea Otter Classic

**Anaheim, Calif. (March 28, 2007)** – Hoss Technical Gear will host an autograph signing with the producer and cast from the mountain bike documentary *Klunkerz* at the Sea Otter Classic in Monterey, CA. The signing will take place at the Hoss booth (number 348) on Friday April 13<sup>th</sup> from 2:00 – 2:30 p.m. Stop by and meet *Klunkerz* producer Billy Savage, as well as mountain bike pioneers Charlie Kelly and Alan Bonds. The trio will be signing *Klunkerz* memorabilia, and shooting the breeze with fat tire fans—who will also be treated to a bit of history, as these guys will be riding some rare vintage bikes.

In the film *Klunkerz* producer Billy Savage blends archival footage, rare photos and interviews with Marin trailblazers to tell the tale of mountain biking's early days in Marin County. What makes *Klunkerz* a very special film is the fact that Billy was able to assemble a cast that's chock full of legendary Marin pioneers: Joe Breeze, Gary Fisher, Alan Bonds, Charlie Kelly, Tom Ritchey, Russ Mahon, Bob Burrows, Wende Cragg, Charlie Cunningham, Otis Guy, Jaquie Phelan, Steve Potts, John Finley Scott, Robert Stewart and Fred Wolf. Charlie Kelly will also be on hand for the autograph session. Charlie is one of the 'Originals' of Marin. His exploits are legendary. Oh yeah, he rides bikes, too. Charlie is the elder statesman of the Marin crew, and has been riding longer than most of his contemporaries. He is credited with being the creator/promoter of the legendary Repack time trial races down Pine Mountain, creating the first magazine (The Fat Tire Flyer) devoted to mountain biking, and starting a little bike company with his buddy Gary. Alan Bonds has been an integral part of the Marin fat-tire scene since the mid-1970s. Alan's involvement with the *Klunkerz* of Marin County began in earnest when he moved into a house with Gary Fisher and Charlie Kelly in 1976. It was there that Alan perfected the craft of building Marin-style *Klunkerz* on Schwinn Excelsior frames. As Gary and Charlie will attest, it was Alan who really got into building up these bikes for others to purchase and ride. Alan also won the first Repack race in October of 1976.
